



This aid comes in two forms: > the one-off aid (ASAP) granted to students facing temporary difficulties that constitute an obstacle in their education. This aid is granted under certain conditions to students under 35 years of age.

the annual aid (ASAA) granted to students facing long-term difficulties. The student must meet the conditions of diploma, studies and nationality established by the regulations relating to higher education studies and grants based on social criteria. In this case, your Student Social File (DSE)
