#### Grants based on social criteria

(DSE) or To receive a grant based on social criteria, you must submit application by completing your Student Social File (DSE messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr

Completing your Student Social File (DSE) is the preliminary step to any application for a grant or an accommodation.

What are the social services? other support services granted by the Crous

To address personal situations, a specific financial aid may be allocated to you. This aid comes in two forms:

> the one-off aid (ASAP) granted to students facing temporary difficulties that constitute an obstacle in their education. This aid is granted under certain conditions to students under 35 years of age. The age limit does not apply to the students with a MDPH certified disability.

the annual aid (ASAA) granted to students facing long-term difficulties. The student must meet the conditions of diploma, studies and nationality established by the regulations relating to higher education grants based on social criteria. In this case, your Student Social File (DSE) must be completed before applying. #### Long-term student accommodation

#### **Crous housing**

To apply for accommodation in the Créteil academic district (77, 93, 94), you must first put together your Student Social File (DSE) on messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr for the upcoming academic year. Once your DSE is constituted, you can apply for housing as soon as the dedicated platform opens. You will be alerted of the start of the housing campaign on crous-creteil.fr as well as on social networks.

Lokaviz website also offers accommodation in private homes. The Lokaviz housing label guarantees decent housing.

#### Short-term student accommodation

## How to receive financial aid from CAF (family allowance fund)?

Are you living in a Crous residence or in the private sector? You may be eligible for the Housing Assistance (AL) fund or the Social Housing Allowance (ALS). You can estimate your rights and apply on: caf.fr

#### Visale rental deposit

Visale is a completely free deposit service for all students under 30 years of age (scholarship holders or non-scholarship holders, tax-independent students) looking for accommodation in the private sector or in university residences. Check your eligibility on visale.fr
